Instructions for the bidders regarding e-auction process:

1. To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get “Digital Signature Certificate” (DSC) as per information Technology Act, 2000. This certificate will be required for digitally signing the bid. Bidders can get above mentioned digital certificate from any approved vendors. The bidders, who already possess valid (DSC) Digital Signature Certificate, need not to procure new Digital Signature Certificate.
2. The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with Digital Signature. The bids cannot be uploaded without Digital Signature. No proposal will be accepted in physical form.
3. The willow trees are auctioned on “**AS IS WHERE IS BASIS**”. The willow section or sections which have been earmarked for auction shall be removed in full from the site including their stump grubbing with all faults and flaws in description or otherwise and no selection or sorting of the trees/material shall be allowed. The quantified weight of felling sections stated is approximate based on local volume table/yield table. Goods are sold on the assumption that the bidders have inspected the lot/felling sections prior to the bidding and know what they are bidding for. No complaint shall be entertained after the highest bid is accepted
4. The interested bidders are requested to quote their rates in lump sum/section-wise in accordance with schedule of advertised quantities with the auction notice. The rates quoted should be complete in all respects considering all taxes, excise duty and freight etc. Taxes/ Levies (State & Central) as applicable on works/activities/material as envisaged in contract shall entirely be borne by the successful bidder/ agency.
5. Before submission online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copies of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid.
6. The bids shall be deposited in electronic format on the website; <http://jktenders.gov.in> as per specified date. The bids (Cover-I) received will be opened in the office of Project Coordinator CAT WUCMA at Rajbagh Srinagar office as per schedule. The original instruments in respect of cost of bidding document, EMD and other relevant documents be submitted to the Tender Inviting Authority only by Highest Bidder (H1).
7. The stocks shown are available at site for felling and conversion and subsequent lifting. The intending bidders are strongly advised to inspect the stocks shown as per site before bidding. The bidder shall in his own interest thoroughly inspect and examine the site, its surroundings, nature of ground, climatic conditions, accessibility and other relevant parameters to decide strategy to be adopted for successful execution/completion of the work, at his own expenses and responsibility before bidding for the advertised work.
8. Bids must be accompanied by bid security (EMD) and cost of tender document as specified above pledged to Project Coordinator Catchment Area Treatment WUCMA. Bid security shall have to be in the form of CDR/FDR and shall have to be valid for one year or more after last date of receipt of Bid. The Bid Document Fee (non-refundable) shall be in the shape of e-challan to be deposited in Government Treasury under major head Forest 0406 and e-challan/receipt of the treasury to be uploaded with bid.
9. Financial bids will be opened online in the office of Project Coordinator Catchment Area Treatment WUCMA Sheikh-ul-Alam Complex near Silk Factory Rajbagh Srinagar on the notified date. If the office happens to be closed on the said date, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.

10. The bid shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of un-priced bid. If any bidder withdraws his bid before the said period or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the bid, the said earnest money shall stand forfeited.
11. The Bid opening/receiving Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in part or in full, without assigning any reason thereof.
12. For any typographical error or omission in the auction/bid document, the interpretation as given by the Department will be final and binding upon the bidders.
13. The Department shall not be responsible for any delay in online submission of the bid due to any reason (technical or otherwise).
14. The Department shall not be held responsible for selection criteria/policy matter being adopted by the Directorate of Information regarding publishing the auction notice, in any of the newspaper under circulation.

DEFINITIONS

In this document, the following terms shall have the meanings assigned here under except where the context otherwise requires:

- I. **“DEPARTMENT”** shall mean the Wular Conservation & Management Authority (WUCMA) or J & K Forest Department as the case may be.
- II. **“AUTHORITY”** shall mean the Wular Conservation & Management Authority (WUCMA).
- III. **“CHIEF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR (CED)”** shall mean the officer in charge of Wular Conservation & Management Authority.
- IV. **“CHIEF CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS (CCF) KASHMIR”** shall mean the officer in charge of territorial divisions of Kashmir region.
- V. **“WILLOW AUCTION COMMITTEE”** shall mean the committee constituted by Government for auctioning of willows falling within the Wular lake (Refer G.O.No. 52/FST of 2019 dated 08/02/2019).
- VI. **“CHAIRMAN WILLOW AUCTION COMMITTEE”** shall mean the Conservator of Forests Kashmir North Circle.
- VII. **“MEMBER SECRETARY WILLOW AUCTION COMMITTEE”** shall mean the Coordinator Catchment Area Treatment (CAT) WUCMA.
- VIII. **“COORDINATOR WATER MANAGEMENT”** shall mean the officer in charge of water management in Wular Conservation and Management Authority.
- IX. **“SUPERINTENDING ENGINEER”** shall mean the Officer in charge for the general superintendence of water management wing of Authority.
- X. **“EXECUTIVE ENGINEER”** shall mean the implementing officer in charge of field engineering wing of WUCMA.
- XI. **“ENGINEER OR ENGINEER IN CHARGE”** shall mean the Executive Engineer Water Management/ Assistant Engineer/ Junior Engineer or any other officer authorized by CED WUCMA to act on his behalf for executing the civil works of Wular lake and for the purpose of operating the contract.
- XII. **“DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER (DFO)”** Shall mean the Divisional Forest Officer, Bandipora Forest Division or Social Forestry Division Baramulla/Bandipora (as the case may be) in charge of willow plantations who shall be responsible for operating the contract.
- XIII. **“RANGE OFFICER”** shall mean the officer in charge of willow plantations and responsible for operating the contract on behalf of concerned Divisional Forest Officer.

- XIV. **“CONTRACTOR”** Shall mean the person, firm or dealer who enters into the contract with the Department and shall include legal representatives of such individual or persons comprising such firm or successors of such firm as the case may be.
- XV. **“BIDDER”** shall mean the person/ the firm or the dealer who bids for the work with a view to execute the works on contract with the Department and shall include their personal representatives, successors and permitted assigns.
- XVI. **“CONTRACT”** shall mean and include the Agreement or Letter of intent, the accepted Statement of advertised Quantities and Rates, the Conditions of Contract, Appendix to Tender, Form of Bid, and Instructions to the Tenderers and other Tender Documents.
- XVII. **“TENDER or BID”** shall mean the offer (Technical and/or Financial) made by individual, firm, or dealer for the procurement of the auctioned commodity.
- XVIII. **“WORKS”** shall mean the works contemplated in the bid document and schedules set forth in the tender forms and required to be executed according to specifications.
- XIX. **“SECTION”** shall mean part of forest beat or compartment delineated by some natural feature on ground which has been put to bid as a whole.
- XX. **“STATEMENT OF ADVERTISED QUANTITIES /“Schedule of Rates”** means list of items of work, their quantities and rates as accepted and forming part of contract agreement.
- XXI. **“APPROVAL OR APPROVED”** means approval in writing including subsequent written confirmation of previous verbal approval.
- XXII. **“SITE”** shall mean the lands and or other place on, under, in or through which the works are to be executed under the contract including any other lands or places which may be allotted by the Department or used for the purpose of contract.
- XXIII. **“COMPLETION”** shall mean when the works specified in the contract are completed in all respects. It shall also mean removal of tools and plants, scaffolding, surplus material, rubbish etc and cleaning of the work site from debris, and making it fit for being taken over by the Department, including removal of tree stumps, branches, lops and tops.
- XXIV. **COMMENCEMENT DATE:** - The date of commencement shall be the seven days after date of issue of Letter of Intent or allotment whichever is earlier.
- XXV. **TIME FOR COMPLETION:** - Means the time for completing the work or a section with any extension calculated from commencement date.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. **Scope of Work**

The present scope of work involves felling/removal of marked willow trees and grubbing of their stumps which are falling within the demarcated limits of Wular Lake in identified/ allotted sections on “**as is where is basis**” and its sale and transportation outside the limits of Lake, after having been duly released by the designated Authority. The work shall be done as per the directions and close supervision of in-charge Range officer, Site Engineer or their authorized representatives of department concerned. The willow section or sections which have been earmarked for auction shall be removed in full from the site including their stump grubbing with all faults and flaws in description or otherwise and no selection or sorting of the trees/material shall be allowed. The quantified weight of felling sections stated is approximate based on local volume table/yield table. Goods are sold on the assumption that the bidders have inspected the lot/felling sections prior to the bidding and know what they are bidding for. No complaint shall be entertained after the highest bid accepted

2. **Tree Removals**

The department has marked willow trees to be cut in sections/coupes. The contractor shall supply a sufficient amount of labour and equipment to remove each tree along with stump in such sections within the specified period. The contractor must follow practices as per state forest department work manual.

3. **Wood**

The contractor shall be responsible for the complete removal and disposal of all wood. Wood may be temporarily stored up in Transit depot approved by the department. All the wood shall be disposed of within the contract period.

4. **Disposal of Debris/Stumps**

The contractor shall be responsible for disposal of all materials/debris as well as stumps resultant from the tree cutting/stump grubbing work at no expense to the department, in manner approved by Range officer concerned.

5. **Eligibility Criteria**

All timber dealers, timber extraction contractors and civil contractors (A,B, C) who are duly registered with J&K State Government/Central Government and having valid license can participate in bidding.

6. Qualification of the Bidder

In order to qualify, all the bidders shall provide copies of documents as defined below:-

- i. PAN Card copy
- ii. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) (*EMD shall be in the form of CDR or FDR, from any Scheduled/Nationalized Bank, having branch in Srinagar for an amount as specified against each section (Refer Appendix-I)*)
- iii. Bid document fee Rs.1000/= (One Thousand Rupees only) (*Bid document fee will be non-refundable which should be deposited in Government Treasury under major head Forest 0406 and e-challan/receipt of the treasury to be provided.*)

7. Documents Comprising the Bid

The bid submitted by the bidder in electronic form shall be in two separate parts:-

Part-I

This shall be named **Technical Bid** and shall comprise of scanned copy of following documents:-

- i. Copy of EMD in the form of CDR/FDR
- ii. Copy of Tender cost in the form of TR.
- iii. Copy of valid Registration certificate of Bidder (Issued by concerned Government Authority)
- iv. Copy of PAN Card

Part-II

It shall be named **financial Bid** and will be in electronic format comprising of

- i. Statement of advertised quantity & rates quoted by the Bidder against each willow section

Each part shall be separately submitted online.

8. Submission of Acceptance Form

The bidder shall submit scanned copy of Acceptance Form attached with this NIT and may be submitted online before last date and time for submission with his bid along with other instruments.

(Refer Appendix-II)

9. Affidavit

An affidavit that, Bidder:-

- ✓ *has not been declared bankrupt by any institution or Government.*
- ✓ *has not been black-listed ever in past by the Government or any other Semi Government organization.*
- ✓ *has not been adjudged by any court as insolvent or was/were not under any law for an offence involving moral turpitude or any criminal activities etc.*
- ✓ *was not detained under any preventive law.*

must be submitted by the Bidder along with the bid. **(Refer Appendix-III)**

(Note):- if the tenderer does not meet the above mentioned criteria, his bid will be rejected.

10. One Bid per Bidder

Each Bidder shall submit only one bid for one or more than one section. A Bidder who submits more than one bid for the same section(s) will cause the proposals with the bidder's participation to be disqualified.

11. Cost of Bidding

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his bid, and the department will, in no case be responsible or liable for those costs.

12. Site Visit

The Bidder, at his own cost, responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit, examine and formalize himself with the quality and quality of timber and its surroundings, of work etc. and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the bid and entering into a contract for purchase of works. The cost of visiting the site shall be at the bidders own expenses

13. Bid Prices

The contract shall be for the whole works based on the priced bill of quantities submitted by the bidder. All duties, taxes, etc and other levies under the contract, or for any other cause, shall be borne and payable by the contractor. The rates and prices quoted by the bidder shall be fixed for the duration of the contract and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.

14. Currency and Language of Bid

The unit rates and the prices shall be quoted by the bidder entirely in Indian Rupees. All payments shall be made in Indian Rupees. The bids shall be prepared in English language only.

15. Bid Validity

Bids shall remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of opening of un-priced bids. Bidder shall not be entitled during the said period of three months, without the consent in writing of the department, to revoke or cancel his bid or to vary the bid given or any term thereof. In exceptional circumstances, prior to expiry of the original time limit, the department may request the bidder to extend the period of validity for a specified additional period. The request and the bidders responses shall be made in writing. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting his earnest money. A bidder agreeing to the request will not be required or permitted to modify his bid, but will be required to extend the validity of his earnest money for a period of the extension.

16. Earnest Money

The bidder shall furnish, as part of the Bid, earnest money as specified in **Appendix-I** against each advertized willow section. The earnest money shall, at the bidder's option, be in the form of CDR/FDR issued from any Scheduled/Nationalized Bank having branch in Srinagar and pledged to **Project Coordinator Catchment Area Treatment WUCMA**. The CDR/FDR shall be valid for one year or more after the last date of receipt of Bids. Any bid not accompanied by an earnest money, pledged in favour of Project Coordinator Catchment Area Treatment shall be rejected by the department as non responsive.

The EMD of the bidders shall be refunded (except three highest bidders). The EMD of successful bidder (Highest Bidder H-1) will be refunded after successful and satisfactory completion of the contract which shall be certified by the Divisional Forest Officer Bandipora concerned. However, EMD of third highest bidder (H-3) shall be released after finalization of the contract and that of 2nd highest bidder (H-2), after the first H-1 starts the work.

17. Confirmation of Acceptance

On completion of e-Auction, the offerer of highest amount will be considered for acceptance of the offer. The Willow Auction Committee shall also have the right to re-tender/re-auction if the highest offered amount is not satisfactory. Mere acceptance of bid/opening of tenders by the officer cannot be deemed as acceptance of the auction bid/tender, unless it is confirmed by the competent authority, who may confirm or reject any auction/tender, including the highest auction bid/tender, without assigning any reasons thereof. If equal amounts are offered by more than one bidder, the matter will be settled as per existing norms. In case of any matter/dispute that may arise in the context of e-auction, the decision of the Chairman Willow Auction Committee or his Authorized Officer who is conducting the e-auction shall be final. The successful e-tenderer/bidder shall be issued an allotment order who shall comply with the terms & conditions furnished herewith and shall execute an Agreement in this regard.

18. Payment of Sale Value (Payment Schedule)

The schedule for payment is as follows:

- (i) After the highest bid is accepted, the successful highest bidder shall deposit 50% of the offered bid amount within 7 days either through direct remittance in Government Treasury or in any other manner prescribed by the department. Thereafter, the proposal for acceptance of bid amount shall be sent to the competent authority for its sanction.
- (ii) After the bid of the successful highest bidder is approved by the competent authority, the highest bidder shall deposit 3% of the bid as security deposit and also the balance 50% of the bid amount to the department either through direct remittance in Government Treasury or in any other manner prescribed by the department at the time of issuance of allotment order.

19. Additional Security Deposit (Performance Security)

Successful H-1 bidder shall have to deposit an additional security deposit of 3% of the contract value as a performance security in the shape of CDR/FDR issued from any scheduled/nationalized bank pledged to Project Coordinator CAT WUCMA at the time of issuance of allotment order. In case the bidder does not furnish additional CDR/FDR within the stipulated time, in addition to forfeiting the earnest money all other action deemed fit may be initiated against the contractor as per terms and conditions of NIT/Standard Bidding Documents.

20. Release of Performance Security

The whole of the Performance Security shall be returned to the Contractor after successful and satisfactory completion of the contract which shall be certified by the Divisional Forest Officer Bandipora concerned.

21. Minimum Reserve Rate

In case the rate offered by any bidder is found below the minimum reserve rate, the reserve rate shall be considered for approval not the offered rate in such case. As such only those bids shall be entertained which are over and above the minimum reserve rate.

22. Completion Period

The entire work is required to be completed in all respects within the time mentioned against each felling section under “**column vii**” in **Appendix-I** from the date of issue of the allotment letter. No extension of contract period shall be granted on ordinary ground. Under very special circumstances, for good and sufficient reasons, the Chairman Willow Auction Committee may grant extension of time for 15 days (fifteen days) on realization of a suitable amount of fine as deemed appropriate.

23. Taxes and Duties

The quoted prices shall be deemed to be exclusive of all taxes and duties including GST, Income tax and any other taxes/duties/levies as applicable during the contract period. All taxes, duties, levies etc shall have to be borne by the contractor. The contractor shall not be compensated for any change in taxes and duties due to wrong assessment. It shall be presumed that bidders have ascertained all applicable taxes, duties, levies, royalties etc. for the said work and quoted rates accordingly. The lifting permission for auctioned material shall be accorded after all tax related deduction certificates are produced by the contractor.

24. Bidding Document, Clarifications And Amendment

- i. A prospective bidder requiring any clarification of the bidding documents may notify the department in writing or by email at the departments address indicated in the Notice inviting Tenders. The department will respond to any request for clarification received earlier than 10 days prior to the deadline for submission of bids. Copies of the department’s response will be uploaded on online portal with a description of the inquiry.
- ii. The Bidding Document shall be read in conjunction with any Amendment / Corrigendum / Addendum/ Clarifications, etc. issued from time to time.
- iii. All Amendments / Corrigendum / Addendum / Clarifications, etc. (if any), shall be hosted on the website <http://www.jktenders.gov.in> only and shall not be published in newspapers or sent by post/e-mail. Hence, all interested /prospective bidders are advised to regularly visit website for any updates. Bidders who submit their bids shall be presumed that they have gone through and are aware of all Amendments / Corrigendum / Addendum / Clarifications / etc. to bidding document (if any) issued and any claim from bidder that such Amendments / Corrigendum / Addendum / Clarifications / etc. to bidding document (if any) were not received by them, will not be entertained.

25. Pre-Bid Meeting

- i. The prospective bidder (s) or his designated representative, who have downloaded the bid document are invited to attend a pre-bid meeting which will take place as per date and venue given in instructions.
- ii. The purpose of meeting will be to clarify issues and to answer queries on any matter that may be raised by the due date.

iv. Any modifications of the bidding documents that may become necessary as a result of the pre-bid meeting shall be made by the department exclusively through the issue of an Amendment/ Corrigendum/Addendum/Clarifications/etc. which shall be hosted on the website <http://www.jktenders.gov.in>.

iv. Non-attendance of the pre-bid meeting will not be a cause for disqualification of the bidder.

26. Amendment of Bidding Document

i. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the department or his authorized representative may, for any reason whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by Bidders, modify the Bidding Document by Amendments /Corrigendum / Addendum / Clarifications / etc.

ii. The Amendment shall be part of the Bidding Document. All Amendments/Corrigendum/ Addendum/Clarifications/ etc. (if any) and shall be hosted on the website <http://www.jktenders.gov.in> only and shall not be published in newspapers or sent by post/e-mail to bidders.

iii. In order to accord bidder reasonable time to take the Amendment into account in preparing their bids, the department may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids.

27. Process to be Confidential and contacting the department

Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of bids and recommendations for the award of a contract shall not be disclosed to bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until the award to the successful bidders has been announced. Any attempt by a bidder to influence the department's processing of bids or award decisions may result in the rejection of his bid. No bidder shall contact the department for any matter relating to its bid from the time of bid opening to the time the contract is awarded. Any attempt by the bidder to influence the department's bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decision may result in the rejection of his bids.

28. Corrupt and Fraudulent Practices

Bidders /Contractors should observe the highest standard of ethics during the execution of Contract. In pursuance of this policy, Department defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:-

“Corrupt Practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of public official in contract execution; and

“Fraudulent Practice” means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence the execution of a Contract to the detriment of department, and includes collusive practise among bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive department of the benefits of free and open competition.

Department will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has engaged corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the Contract in question.

Fraud Prevention Policy: The bidder along with its associate / collaborator / sub-contractors / sub-vendors/consultants /service providers shall strictly adhere to the Fraud Prevention Policy of Employer

and shall immediately apprise the Employer about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice. If in terms of above policy it is established that the bidder/ his representatives have committed any fraud while competing for this contract then the bid security of the bidder shall be forfeited

29. Quantity Variation

Contractor shall not be entitled for any compensation for any decrease in quantity shown as expected outturn in quintals from willow felling coupes/sections. The said estimation is based on local volume table/yield table which is in vogue in department and therefore contractor is strongly advised to visit and examine the site, its surroundings and familiarize himself with the actual yield from marked willow trees, and collect all other information which he may require before preparing and submitting the bid and entering into the contract. Claims and objections due to ignorance of existing conditions, lack of knowledge of local volume table/yield table functions or inadequacy of information will not be considered after submission of the bid and during implementation.

30. Transit Depot

Felled willows and grubbed stumps shall have to be kept at registered transit depot which shall be registered by Divisional Forest Officer, Bandipora Forest Division and its further release from the transit depot shall be subject to issuance of transit permit (F-25) from the competent authority after necessary certification is sought from the bidder/ agency regarding its final destination/ route opted. Transportation of the felled/ grubbed out stocks to the destination shall be governed by the rules and regulations applicable for movement of the species involved under rules.

31. Accident or Injury to Workmen

WUCMA shall not be liable for or in respect of any damages or compensation payable at law in respect or in consequence of any accident or injury to any workman or other person in the employment of the contractor or any sub-contractor his agents or servants and the contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the department against all such damages and compensation and against all claims, demands, proceeding, costs, charges and expenses, whatsoever in respect or in relation thereto.

32. Jurisdiction

The contract shall be governed by and constructed according to the laws in force in Jammu and Kashmir. The contractor hereby submits to the jurisdiction of the courts situated at Srinagar for the purposes of disputes, actions and proceedings arising out of the contract. The courts at Srinagar only will have the jurisdiction to hear and decide such disputed actions and proceedings.

33. Sub-Contracting

No sub-contracting will be permissible. Any violation shall mean disqualification/rejection of the allotted contract. However contractor may adopt piece work system in respect of supply of materials or supply of equipments of special nature but shall be fully responsible to the Govt. for the omissions and commissions of piece work and of person either directly or indirectly employed.

34. Right to Accept or Reject Tenders/Bids

- i. The Willow Auction Committee reserves the right to accept, split, divide, negotiate, cancel or reject any tender/bid or to annul and reject all tenders/bids at any time prior to the award of the contract without incurring any liability to the affected tenderers/bidders or any obligation to inform affected tenderer/bidder, the grounds of such action.
- ii. If the tenderer/bidder deliberately gives wrong information in his tender/bid or creates illegal circumstances for the acceptance of his tender, Committee reserves the right to forfeit his earnest money and reject such bid at any stage. Such bidder shall also be liable to be debarred from all future tendering/bidding in the state of J&K (India).

35. Insurance

Any accidental or incidental occurrence during the course of execution shall be entirely liability of the contractor. The contractor has to observe due care and caution as not to cause damage to life/honour/property or cause mishap, nuisance. The insurance cover of the team members working for the project shall be responsibility of the contractor.

36. Decision of Chairman Willow Auction Committee to be final

Except where otherwise specified in this contract, the decision of Chairman Willow Auction Committee shall be final, conclusive and binding upon the contractor on all questions relating to the meaning of the specifications and instructions herein before mentioned and as to the quality, the workmanship or materials used for the work.

37. Alteration in Bidding Document

If any bidder proposes any alteration to any of the conditions laid herein or proposes any other conditions of any description, whatsoever, his / her tender/bid is liable to be rejected.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Each Lot/section is a separate entity for bidding. Bidders have to bid separately for each Lot. The bidders may submit bids for any or all of the lots/sections detailed in the Appendix-I of this NIT. Bid for each lot/section should be submitted separately as per format.
2. WUCMA will not be responsible for pilferage of marked/enumerated trees or stocks once handed over to contractor.
3. The contractor while making sale of the willow stocks and stumps, has to dispose of the material at his own cost from dumping site & arrange the transporting facility by himself.
4. The contractor shall cut the designated trees, shift & transport the cut trees for weightment by employing their own labour and transports at their own risk and cost from the designated site within the time stipulated in the terms and conditions of tender or within such time, as the case may be, prescribed. The contractor shall follow the procedure for taking the material out of the Wular demarcated limits abiding by all labour laws, statutory provisions, safety regulations will be the sole responsibility of the successful bidder.
5. If any damage or loss is caused to the property other than the property in contract, or any claims are made against WUCMA by reason of any act of commissions or negligence on the part of the contractor or on the part of their agents, representatives or employees, WUCMA shall be entitled to recover such losses or damages or claim as may be ascertained by the officer in charge from any amount due to the contractor such as Earnest Money/Security Deposit (as the case may be).
6. The contractor shall follow the Departmental procedure in regard to the issue of Passes for taking the material out of the site. The contractor shall use for the above purpose only truck/vehicles/cranes having area passes recommended by the contractor and issued by appropriate authority. All the Motor Truck, Tractor, Trailers, Cranes and other material handling equipment of the contractor shall be duly registered, taxes paid properly and otherwise properly maintained in accordance with the Motor Vehicle or rules of any other act in force. The Department shall allow a reasonable number of the contractors authorized representatives, workers and trucks at the sole discretion of the contractor of entering in to the work site for the purpose of removal and transportation of the materials.
7. The contractor shall supply safety equipment and appliances to their workers at their own cost. It shall be entirely the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that their vehicles are not driven with so high speed or prove to be potential threat to the safety of the traffic. Where speed limit has been fixed, the contractor and their drivers will strictly adhere to slow and safe driving.
8. The contractor shall be fully responsible for the acts of his representative's workers and shall fully indemnify department for losses, damages, sustained. The department will not be responsible for any claim from labour employed by the contractor. The contractor shall wholly and fully be responsible for such claim for compensation either for accident or injury, death or damage caused during operation to

their employees transport or to any of the contractors employees or to other or to the contractors property.

9. The contractor or any of his representatives, workers/agents shall not indulge in any activity which is directly or indirectly prejudicial to departmental interest or shall not commit any acts of (a) misappropriation, pilferage or abetting misappropriation or pilferage of contractor's property or any attempt thereof offer or attempt to offer illegal gratification including offering bribe, reward or advantages etc. pecuniary or otherwise to any officer or employee of department (b) indulge in any malpractice, forgery, falsification or fabrication of documents, bills, vouchers, indents etc. in support of any claim against department for any reduction of any liability or in connection with the work of department or indulge in any other act which amounts to an offence punishable under the Forest Act/ Renal penal code or any other enactment. Such acts will lead to termination of contract.
10. The contractor shall abide by the Central, State Labour Legislation as may be applicable from time to time. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to provide necessary insurance cover to their workers, labourers as may be required under the law.
11. If the contractor is found to have felled or damaged any tree / cut any branch of a tree not included in the contract, the contract shall be cancelled and the security deposit shall be forfeited in addition to prosecuting for the offence. The contractor may be blacklisted also.
12. The contractor shall have to arrange for the necessary permits from forest department/police department himself and which shall not be the responsibility of WUCMA.
13. The movement of willow will be governed by "The Jammu and Kashmir Willow Act", 2000 **and Land Transport Rules of J & K Forest Act**. The department shall not be responsible for any damage due to detention/haltage of trucks for whatsoever reason or due to violation of land transport rules/ J & K Willow Act.
14. On no account will any claim for compensation for loss sustained due to fluctuation of price in the market of logs or cost of labour during the tenure of the contract will be considered.
15. The watch and ward of all material/machinery shall be the responsibility of the Contractor/Agency.
16. The contractor shall use standard tools and equipment in extraction works at his own cost and without causing any damage to other infrastructure e.g., Cable lines, electric poles and telephone lines or any un-marked trees at the site. In case of any lapses, the damage caused (if any) shall be recovered from the contractor in full besides legal action as warranted.
17. In case of violation of any of the terms and conditions of the tender/contract by any bidder at any stage, the department reserves the right to cancel the tender/bid/contract and to forfeit EMD/performance security of that bidder.
18. The litigation(s) arising out of this contract shall not be inculpatory for the WUCMA. Although the department shall endeavor to take necessary steps for management and disposal of such litigations,

however the contractor shall not have claim to any payment of compensation otherwise whatsoever on account of any profit or advantage which he might have derived from the execution of the works in full but which he could not derive in consequence of any court order.
